

Organization of language courses:

- > Courses are taught from the end of September to mid-April depending on the chosen registration
- The course schedule is available during registration
- Classes are taught in the classrooms at the Centre des Langues or in the classrooms located in the Law and Letters building of the University
- A visit to the Library and Media Library can be organized at the beginning of the semester

Qualification of teachers: Our teachers are teachers at the University and/or native speakers of the language they teach.

Registration conditions: Registration is on site during the registration periods each semester; registration for a semester or for the year. Possibility of registering for several language courses. Payment methods are: cash, check payable to the Regisseur du Centre des Langues or online, on request.

Intercultural Program for European Credits

For international and French students at the UBE: The program consists of three hours of presence per week over 11 weeks at the Language Centre to accompany users in the learning and practice of your native language. During this period, you will organize a special event to present your culture and/or organize weekly activities and missions at the Centre (to be decided in agreement with the head of the Language Center). You will choose to attend one language class per week (generally 1h30 per week over 10 weeks) leading to a graded exam that will count in the final average for your participation in the program. It is mandatory to have fulfilled your 33 hours of presence at the Centre and to have organized a special cultural event. You must also attend your language courses regularly and take the final exam to obtain your 5 ECTS credits. More information: centre.langues.cultures@ube.fr
