CHINESE COURSE BEGINNER LEVEL CEFR Level A1

10 sessions of 2 hours per semester

Prerequisites: None



<u>General</u> objectives :

- Master the basics of spoken Chinese and be able to recognise Chinese characters encountered in daily life in China.
- Each lesson includes role-playing and scenarios to help you memorize through practice.

<u>Learning</u> objectives :

- Phonetics: master the rules of pronunciation and tones.
 Pronounce the 4 tones correctly.
- Vocabulary: master 200 new words (spoken and written), know the pronunciation, spelling and meaning of these words and how to use them.
- Grammar: use sentences with successive verbs expressing manner and sentences with alternative questions, master frequency and degree complements, affirmative-negative questions, etc.
- Communication: be able to express yourself on your personal life, family, work, leisure and matters related to everyday life.
- Know how to invite or decline an invitation and apologize.
- Reading and writing: be able to read simple sentences and messages; be able to write simple sentences in Chinese words relating to daily life.
- Cultural knowledge: discover festivals, traditional Chinese arts and the most common customs. Discover the codes of communication between Chinese people.
