CHINESE COURSE BEGINNER LEVEL CEFR Level A2

10 sessions of 2 hours per semester

Prerequisites : A1 Level



<u>General</u> objectives:

- Master the basics of spoken Chinese and be able to recognise Chinese characters encountered in daily life in China.
- Each lesson includes role-playing and scenarios to help you memorize through practice.

<u>Learning</u> objectives:

- Phonetics: express yourself in appropriate tones during a conversation.
- Vocabulary: master 200 new words (spoken and written); know the pronunciation, spelling and meaning of these words and how to use them.
- Grammar: know how to express comparisons, master duration complements, direction complements and sentences constructed with 'ba'. Use duration complements, potential complements, the continuation and progression of an action and complex sentences.
- Communication: making comparisons, sightseeing. Use daily expressions and vocabulary; be able to obtain or give information.
- Reading and writing: be able to read simple sentences and messages, understand instructions and obtain the necessary information by reading short document.
- Cultural knowledge: learn about climate and tourism in China. Understanding Chinese traditions, customs and social life.
