ENGLISH CONSOLIDATION COURSE CEFR A2 LEVEL

10 sessions of 1h30 per semester Pre-requisites: This course is designed for anyone wishing to consolidate their linguistic foundations through simple sentences in typical everyday and professional situations. Fragmentary knowledge of the language (limited comprehension, many hesitations in exchanges, limited vocabulary).



General objectives:

- Consolidate previous knowledge
- Gain confidence in speaking
- Acquire correct pronunciation
- Understand a simple general conversation
- Write a simple message

Teaching objectives:

- Reviewing the basics: useful expressions for greeting, introducing oneself, spelling a name, asking to repeat...
- Revision of tenses:
- Present simple / Present progressive
- Past simple / Present perfect
- Future tenses
- The conditional
- Main modals: can / should / may
- General grammatical revisions: Comparatives and superlatives;
 Prepositions; THERE IS/ THERE ARE; SOME/ ANY
- Acquisition and / or revision of everyday vocabulary: Asking for directions; going to a hotel, restaurant, ordering a dish, a drink.
- Oral comprehension and activities (audio and video support).
- Revision of basic written formulas and drafting of e-mails (formal and informal).
- Revision: basic expressions / time / dates / numbers...

Teaching methods:

- Active teaching based on real-life situations.
- Oral comprehension training (audio and video documents) in the language laboratory.
- Oral and written exercises: pair work, written work (individual or in pairs).

Teaching materials:

These are provided by the teacher: Audiovisual aids, extracts from books by different publishers, grammar exercises, glossaries, etc.

<u>Level</u> assessment :

A 30-minute test including grammar, vocabulary and expression questions will be given to learners to assess their progress.
