ARABIC COURSE BEGINNER LEVEL CEFR Level A1

10 sessions of 1h30 per semester

Prerequisites: none



Presentation:

The course focuses on learning Arabic in order to communicate easily in a language that is understood throughout the Arabic cultural world - the language of today's media, satellite channels, the internet and social networks (Arabic literal).

<u>General</u> objectives:

This course is designed to acquire a basic knowledge of the Arabic language.

- The Arabic alphabets
- Indentification of the letters at each position in the word
- Masculine and feminine forms.

You will read short texts at elementary level and learn to express yourself, both orally and in writing, in simple and practical everyday situations.

<u>Learning</u> objectives:

The learning objectives vary according to level. They are in line with the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). Beginner Arabic A1 is an introductory level which enables you to:

- Read syllabically and write Arabic letters.
- Understand and use daily expressions and very simple statements aimed at satisfying concrete needs.
- Introduce yourself or someone else.
- Be able to ask a person questions about themselves and answer the same types of questions.
- Communicate simply if the other person speaks slowly and clearly

Teaching methods:

- Pedagogical and communicative approach.
- The teacher monitors the student's progress throughout the course
- Practical exercises.

<u>Level</u> assessment:

A final test will enable you to position yourself in relation to the learning objectives of the course.
