ARABIC COURSE CONSOLIDATION LEVEL CEFR Level A2

10 sessions of 1h30 per semester

Prerequisites: level A1

Presentation:

This course is a continuation of the introduction to literal Arabic with emphasis on grammar, conjugation, comprehension and written expression. It is designed for learners who have successfully completed the A1 level.

<u>General</u> <u>objectives :</u>

This course will enable you to immerse yourself in the Arabic language and culture. You will consolidate your listening and speaking skills through the study of authentic documents (extracts from songs, advertisements or posters).

Learning objectives :

Learning of the main rules of Arabic grammar needed to understand modern texts on your own such as reading a text without vowels. Emphasis is placed on the acquisition of basic syntactic and morphological structures and the use of Arabic dictionaries. During this module, the textbook Arabic 2nd year - LV2 (A2, A2+) will be used for revision and practice, enabling learners to acquire level A2.

Teaching methods:

Classes: with a teacher.

Audiovisual aids: videos, podcasts ...

Practical exercises: writing activities, group conversations.

<u>Level</u> assessment :

A final test will be organised to position yourself in relation to the learning objectives of the course.
