COURSE OF FRENCH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE BEGINNER LEVEL A1 Level of the CEFR

10 sessions of 1h30 per semester	Prerequisites : none
<u>General</u> objectives :	 Understand and use daily expressions and simple phrases aimed at satisfying immediate needs. Introduce yourself and others and give basic personal information about your home, possessions and acquaintances.
<u>Learning</u> objectives:	 Learn to interact in simple daily situations : introduce yourself, understand general information including basic facts, describe where you live and people around you, express your intentions, feelings and basic needs, understand and write simple messages. Learn basic grammar rules. Know the basic vocabulary. Improve your pronunciation.
<u>Teaching methods</u> :	 Each course focuses on the four skills : listening comprehension (CO), reading comprehension (CE), speaking (EO) and writing (EE), with particular emphasis on phonetics and phonology, especially at the beginning of the program. Homework is planned. Ideas for homework can be sketched out, explained and adapted individually to suit each student's profile.
