COURSE OF FRENCH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE A2 Level of the CEFR

10 sessions of 1h30 per semester	Prerequisites : A2 level
<u>General</u> objectives :	 Understand and use frequently used expressions and simple phrases to meet immediate needs. Be able to communicate and exchange simple information on familiar and routine matters. Describe his/her work/study environment and needs.
<u>Learning</u> <u>objectives</u> :	 Learn to interact in simple daily situations : introductions, timetables, personal letters, general or specific information, description of your environment (familiar and professional), use of comparison and duration. Learn more about the basic rules of grammar. Know vocabulary for familiar, professional and leisure activities.
<u>Teaching</u> <u>methods</u> :	 Each course focuses on the four skills : listening comprehension (CO), reading comprehension (CE), speaking (EO) and writing (EE), with particular emphasis on oral interaction. Homework is planned. Ideas for homework can be sketched out, explained and adapted individually to suit each student's profile.
<u>Teaching</u> <u>materials :</u>	 Manuals : La grammaire des premiers temps, A1-A2, FLE PUG and Grammaire du français, multi-niveaux A1 à B1, Hachette Manuals « Progressif » CLE International : vocabulaire, communication, grammaire, conjugaison, orthographe, niveau intermédiaire, avec des exercices Manual : Edito A2, Didier Websites such as : www.lesZexperts.com, wwwTV5monde.com, www.lefrançaisdesaffaires.com Sheets containing useful Internet links according to level (i.e. online dictionaries, phonetics, conjugation, dictation, songs, literature: texts and audio books, recorded audio-video extracts, etc.).
Level assessment :	The four skills (CO, EO, CE, EE) are assessed after 2 written TESTS in class and an individual oral presentation.
