COURSE OF FRENCH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE B1 Level of the CEFR

10 sessions of 1h30 per semester	Prerequisites: A2 level
<u>General</u> objectives :	 Understand and use expressions to get by (formally and informally) in frequently encountered situations : travelling, work or training. Be able to communicate and discuss - in a simple way - more or less familiar events or experiences. Be able to express a wish, a goal or an idea.
<u>Learning</u> objectives :	 Learn to interact in daily situations : have sufficient linguistic skills to express yourself on familiar subjects, be able to react to current events, including speaking in conversations, describe your professional/study environment, master the expression of advice and the flow of ideas in a text and orally. Learn more about the basic rules of grammar. Know vocabulary for familiar, professional and leisure activities.
<u>Teaching</u> methods :	 Each course focuses on the four skills : listening comprehension (CO), reading comprehension (CE), speaking (EO) and writing (EE), with particular emphasis on oral interaction. Homework is planned. Ideas for homework can be sketched out, explained and adapted individually to suit each student's profile.
<u>Teaching</u> <u>materials</u> :	 Manuals : La grammaire des premiers temps, B1-B2 FLE, PUG and Grammaire du français, multi-niveaux A1 à B1, Hachette Manuals of « Progressif », CLE International : vocabulaire, communication, grammaire, conjugaison, orthographe, niveau intermédiaire, avec des exercices Websites such as : www.lesZexperts.com, wwwTV5monde.com, www.lefrançaisdesaffaires.com Sheets containing useful Internet links according to level (i.e. online dictionaries, phonetics, conjugation, dictation, songs, literature: texts and audio books, recorded audio-video extracts, etc.).
Level assessment :	The four skills (CO, EO, CE, EE) are assessed after 2 written TESTS in class and an individual oral presentation.
