

COURSE OF FRENCH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE ADVANCED LEVEL B2 Level of the CEFR



10 sessions of 1h30
per semester

Prerequisites : B1 level

General objectives :

- Become independent in daily life as well as in more specific situations, while developing and consolidating the foundations already acquired.
- Understand the specific nature of the language and learn the general cultural codes.

Learning objectives :

- Understand the main ideas of complex speeches on most concrete or abstract topics in a standard language at a normal speed.
- Understand articles or documents on contemporary issues and complex texts.
- Speak clearly and in detail on subjects related to your interests :
- Explain the advantages and disadvantages of an option or concept
- Communicate with spontaneity and ease, using a targeted and enriched vocabulary
- Take part in a conversation on familiar subjects and defend a point of view
- Write clear, detailed and well-argued texts on a range of subjects related to personal interests or current affairs, structuring the information and articulating the discourse (mastery of logical connectors).

Teaching methods :

- The four skills : listening comprehension (CO), reading comprehension (CE), speaking (EO) and writing (EE) will be systematically developed during the sessions, usually in interaction, through various activities based on authentic and varied documents, often taken from the media (extracts from press articles, interviews or debates on the radio, internet or TV).
- Homework is planned but not systematic.
