10 sessions of 1h30 per semester	Prerequisite : B2 level
<u>General</u> objectives :	The aim of the course is to help students acquire linguistic and civilizational skills through the use of a variety of media that link their pragmatic, linguistic or civilizational knowledge to the tasks at hand.
<u>Learning</u> objectives :	 Listening comprehension : Medium-length audio documents (4 to 6 minutes) on a variety of topical subjects. Broadcast of extracts from news reports. Each document is discussed and the vocabulary acquired is specific to the communication situations covered. Written comprehension : Articles taken from the daily press in which the author's opinion is strongly expressed. Contemporary literary texts. Work on the vocabulary used in the texts: synonymous research, etc. Oral expression : Discussions on the themes raised by the authentic documents. Role-play practice of language structures learnt in lessons. Written productions involving the re-use of language structures identified in authentic documents. Writing exercises to improve syntax. Produce texts based on the expression of personal opinions and the use of logical articulators. Grammar : Review of simple and compound tenses Past tenses Prepositions The complex sentence Circumstantial clauses of time, purpose and cause
Level assessment:	 The subjunctive tense The particularities of colloquial language The five skills (CO, EO, EO, CE, EE) will be assessed in the final session.
