GERMAN COURSE BEGINNER LEVEL CEFR Level A1



10 sessions of 1.5 hours per semester

Prerequisites: None

General Objectives:

- Acquire basic grammar skills in the language
- Acquire correct pronunciation
- Be able to understand and conduct a simple conversation
- Be able to understand and write a simple written message

<u>Learning</u> objectives:

- Learn useful expressions for greeting people, introducing yourself, spelling your name, asking someone to repeat something, etc., as well as basic expressions for telling the time, dates, numbers, age, etc.
- Acquisition of the present tense conjugation of weak and strong verbs, separable phrasal verbs, modal verbs, and auxiliary verbs
- Acquisition of the basics of morphosyntax: the position of the verb in the main clause, plural nouns, pronouns, possessive articles, the three genders, cases and their functions
- Acquisition of everyday vocabulary: age, family, profession, leisure activities; going to a restaurant, ordering a meal or a drink; knowing how to express a wish, a desire, a need, a necessity, an ability/skill, an intention, feelings; knowing how to say how you feel. Activités d'entraînement à l'expression et à la compréhension orale

Teaching methods:

Interactive teaching based on real-life situations.

- Listening comprehension training (audio and video materials) in the language lab.
- Oral and written role-playing exercises: individual or pair/group work, creation and staging of dialogues to promote oral expression

Teaching materials:

The course will be based on the following method: MOTIVE A1, Kompaktkurs, DaF, Hueber 2015

It would be preferable for students to obtain the following before the start of classes:

- Kursbuch A1, Lektionen 1 8 (manuel)
- Arbeitsbuch A1, Lektionen 1 8 (cahier d'activités)

Level assessment:

The five skills (CO, EO, EOI, CE, EE) will be assessed regularly.
