GERMAN COURSE CONSOLIDATION LEVEL CEFR Level A2



10 sessions of 1.5 hours per semester

Prerequisite: Have completed level A1 of the CEFR

General objectives :

- > Acquire basic grammar skills in the language
- > Acquire correct pronunciation
- ➤ Be able to understand and conduct a simple conversation
- > Be able to understand and write a simple written message

<u>Learning</u> <u>Objectives</u>:

- Acquiring useful expressions for reading travel brochures, booking a trip, writing shopping lists, shopping, taking a tour of the city, writing postcards, creating a joint plan, and expressing your opinion.
- Transmission of cultural knowledge: events in Germany, Austria and Switzerland, knowledge of German literature, famous personalities from the 'DACH' countries (= Deutschland, Austria, Confoederatio Helvetica).

Teaching methods:

Grammar review:

- ➤ Das Perfekt, possessive articles (the possessive article in the nominative, accusative and dative cases)
- ➤ Local prepositions in the dative and accusative cases (auf, vor, zwischen, über ...)
- > The indefinite article, adjective declension, temporal prepositions

Teaching materials:

- > Interactive teaching based on real-life situations.
- Listening comprehension training (audio and video materials)
- Oral and written role-playing exercises: individual or pair/group work, creation and staging of dialogues to promote oral expression
