

KOREAN LANGUAGE COURSE - CONSOLIDATION LEVEL CEFR Level A2



11 two-hour
sessions per
semester

Prerequisites: This course is
suitable for students who have
already acquired 800 basic
words.

General objectives:

- Develop students' curiosity to learn more about a growing country.
- Prepare students to interact with a major North-East Asian nation.
- Expose them to a new, rich and interesting culture.
- Offer them the opportunity to learn the basics of a language that is still rarely taught in French secondary schools.

Learning objectives:

- Learn to make yourself understood in everyday situations in Korea.
- Express yourself using a vocabulary of approximately 2,000 words.
- Know the main registers of language - informal and formal

Teaching methods:

- First stage of level A1.2 (with reference to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages)
- Talking about future events, asking for directions
- Ask for and give information about the weather, ask for the other person's opinion, express a desire
- Expressing surprise, expressing respect, asking to choose between several answers
- Expressing tastes and preferences, expressing ability or inability, expressing possibility or impossibility
- Ask for explanations, express obligation, cause, purpose, give advice
- Asking someone's opinion, giving advice, making assumptions, comparing people and things
- Expressing probability, justifying oneself, defending oneself, expressing one's competence
- Expressing surprise, expressing appreciation, expressing probability, willingness, obligation, asking for and giving permission
- Talk about future and recent events, ask for explanations, remind someone what they need to do
- Discussing the price of something, expressing doubt, justifying oneself, expressing dissatisfaction

Teaching materials:

- Work on textbooks for learning Korean:

- *Cours de coréen 1*
- Work on the PPT adapted to the students' levels.
- Emphasis on oral communication
- Training through role-playing and immersion

Level assessment:

The four skills (CO, EO, CE, EE) will be assessed.
