

CSPANISH COURSE

BEGINNER LEVEL

CEFR Level A1



10 sessions of 1.5
hours per semester

Prerequisites : None

General objectives:

- Understand and use everyday expressions that are very common, as well as simple sentences designed to meet immediate needs.
- Introduce yourself and others, ask for and give basic personal information about your home, possessions and acquaintances.
- Interact in a basic manner, provided that the other person speaks slowly and clearly and is willing to cooperate.
- Be able to understand and write a simple written message.

Learning objectives :

- Learn how to greet people, give and ask for contact details.
- Be able to express your intentions, feelings and basic needs.
- Talk about your interests and tastes.
- Learn how to find your way around a city and ask for directions.
- Learn basic grammar rules: verbs in the present tense (regular and irregular), gender and number, personal pronouns, possessive pronouns, prepositions, adverbs of place, etc.
- Learn basic everyday vocabulary: numbers, nationalities, professions, leisure activities, family members, food, etc

Teaching methods:

- The teacher will speak Spanish as much as possible so that students become familiar with the language and its pronunciation.
- In general, each lesson focuses on several language skills (CO, CE, EE, EO), with particular attention paid to CO through videos and audio materials, and to EO through role-playing dialogues.

Teaching materials:

The course will be based on the following method: *Aula internacional 1*

Level assessment:

The four skills (CO, EO, CE, EE) will be assessed regularly.
