SPANISH COURSE CONSOLIDATION LEVEL CEFR Level A2



10 sessions of 1.5 hours per semester

 Prerequisites: Have completed level A1 or have studied Spanish before.

General objectives:

- Consolidate the basics of oral and written expression
- Consolidate basic vocabulary and work on advanced vocabulary to become independent users;
- Consolidate the basics of Spanish grammar and work on more advanced structures.

<u>Learning</u> <u>objectives:</u>

- Review Spanish conjugation and prepositions, and introduce students to more advanced structures.
- Consolidate spelling.
- Learn to express opinions and needs, and recount past experiences.
- Work on advanced vocabulary (vocabulary useful for describing images and analysing a message, justifying one's point of view, etc.).
- Be able to understand an original video document.

Teaching methods:

The course aims to work on several language skills in each session, with a particular focus on CO through short films and EO through improvisation exercises.

Teaching materials:

Students will receive a brochure prepared by the teacher.

Level assessment:

The four skills (CO, EO, CE, EE) will be assessed.
