SPANISH COURSE INTERMEDIATE LEVEL CEFR Level B1



10 sessions of 1.5 hours per semester

Prerequisite: Level A2

General Objectives:

- Understand and use expressions to get by (formally and informally) in frequently encountered situations: when travelling, at work, in training.
- Be able to communicate and exchange in a simple way about events or experiences that are more or less familiar.
- Be able to express a wish, a goal, an idea.

<u>Learning objectives</u>

- Learn to interact in everyday situations: acquire sufficient linguistic skills to express yourself on familiar topics, but also to respond to current events and participate in conversations; describe your professional/academic environment; master the expression of advice and the sequencing of ideas in writing and orally.
- Consolidate basic grammar rules.
- Know the vocabulary of familiar, professional and leisure areas.

Teaching methods:

Each course focuses on the four skills: listening comprehension (LC), reading comprehension (RC), speaking (S) and writing (W), with a particular emphasis on oral interaction.

Teaching materials

Students will receive a brochure prepared by the teacher.

Level assessment:

The four skills (LC, RC, S, W) are assessed at the end of two written tests in class and an oral presentation.
