Level assessment:

- This course will immerse you in Italian language and culture. You will consolidate your oral and written comprehension and expression skills by working on authentic documents (articles, film or documentary excerpts, interviews, advertisements).
- The lessons will be organised according to a thematic criterion. Each theme will provide an opportunity to practise language skills, discovering new words and practising speaking in group discussions, as well as cultural skills, with the aim of offering students access to Italian culture that they might not otherwise have the opportunity to discover on their own.
- At each session, the teacher will propose one or more documents (oral and/or written) to work on and discuss.
- Preparing a final oral presentation will allow you to develop the course content and work on your oral expression through personal research.
