LEVEL

Level A2 of the CEFR



30 sessions of

Prerequisite: Have completed the first level
A1.1

General objectives:

- Expand your vocabulary
- Lay the foundations of signed syntax
- Consolidate mastery of spatial and temporal landmarks
- Grammar lessons

Learning objectives:

- Enrich vocabulary and communication situations (professional, personal, etc.)
- Master the 5 parameters of LSF, grammar and syntax specific to sign languages
- Work on transfers
- Learn directional verbs
- Enhance your knowledge of the cultural, historical and linguistic characteristics of the deaf community.

Teaching methods:

- Alternating between class time and discussion time, homework will be assigned
- Role-playing exercises
- Practical dialogue exercises in Sign Language
- Regular work with the camera, recording productions and direct reinvestment in the course
- All lessons and exercises will be conducted entirely in LSF, without any use of spoken French.
- The 'table' medium and written French will be used whenever necessary.
- USB stick with at least 8 GB of storage and a whiteboard

Teaching materials:

- Putting what you have learned into practice : interaction and dialogue exercises
- Group reviews of filmed productions
- Exercises on paper and via video projection : checks and corrections following learning that has been acquired or is in the process of being acquired
- Dialogue exercises related to the vocabulary learned
- Written and signed evaluations
- Film screenings on the theme of sign language and the deaf community

Level assessment:

The four skills (CO, EO, CE, EE) will be assessed.
